
East-West Center Offers Intercultural Workshop

From July 15 to 24, 1992, the Institute of Culture and Communication at the East-West Center will offer a workshop for college and university faculty who wish to develop courses in intercultural and international topics. Participants will examine possible texts, interact with East-West Center staff familiar with a variety of courses, discuss issues with the authors of texts currently used in intercultural courses, share ideas with each other, and become familiar with concepts that can be integrated into various courses.
