The U.S.A. - Vol. I.The Land and The People, Robert J. Dixson. Vol. II, Men and History Robert J. Dixson and Herbert Fox. Vol. III, Men and Machines Customs and Institutions, Ethel Tiersky and Martin Tiersky Simon and Schuster, New York. Price \$1.25 each.

These books meet the need for readable, inexpensive, high-interest material for the foreign student. The four volumes have interesting and readable stories relating to the history and geography of the United States, and its important men, customs, and institutions. Each book is independent of the others, and has a specific vocabulary range: Book I, 1200 words; Book II 1600

words; Book III, 2000 words and Book IV, 2400 words.

Each of the short 3-4 page reading exercises is followed by either a converstation and vocabulary drill exercise or a comprehension exercise. There is much variety in the style and content of the drills in different volumes.

Conversation exercises provide useable

discussion material.
